The western scholars Paul Deussen, Kith and Winternitz have shown the chronicles of the creation of these Upanishad.

In fact, it is a very difficult task to establish the exact chronicles of the creation of the Upanishads. That is why Paul Deussen says,

‘ earlier and later texts (exist) side by side hence the age of each individual piece must be determined separately.’

Ish, Ken, Kath, Prashna, Mundak, Mandukya, Taittiriya, Aaitereya, Chhandogya, Bruhadaranyaka, Shevetasvatar, Kaushitaki and Maitrayani Upanishad are the Thirteen Principal Upanishads, By reading the Introduction of these 13 Upanishads we gather the following ideas.

According to Ranade,

“ Upanishadic Poetry is mystical, moral or metaphysical rather than heroic or lyrical or given to the description of nature or love.”

“ It is this idea of the logical synthesis of opposites which is an unconscious contribution which the sage of the Upanishad makes to the development of Indian thought.”

(Ishavasyopanishad)

According to Anarold Advin,

The subtle thought, the far of faith,

The deathless spirit mocking Death,

The close – packed sense, hard to unlock

As diamond from the mother – rock,

The solemn, brief simplicity,

The insight, Fancy, mystery of Hindoo scriptures – all are had in this divine Upanishad. (Kathopanishad)

We find Yajnavalkya as a great philosopher in Bruhadaranyak Upanishad.

Yajnavalkya is undoubtedly the greatest philosopher of the Upanishadic times who by his consistent philosophical idealism and by his through going practical Atmanism, may give lessons to many a thinker of the present day.

There is a description of the elements of ‘Sankhya philosophy’, the six constituents of yoga and the principles of ‘Hathyoga’
